# Euclidean Distance Based Classifier for Recognition and Generating Kannada Text Description from Live Sign Language Video

Abstract—Sign language recognition has emerged in concert of the vital space of analysis in computer Vision. The problem long-faced by the researchers is that the instances of signs vary with each motion and look. The system includes of three stages: Preprocessing stage, Feature Extraction and Classification. Preprocessing stage includes skin filtering, bar histogram matching. Eigen values and Eigen Vectors were thought of for feature extraction stage and at last Eigen value weighted Euclidean distance is employed to acknowledge the sign. It deals with vacant hands, so permitting the user to act with the system in natural manner. We have got thought of completely different alphabets within the video sequences and earned a hit rate of 95.25%.

# 1 Introduction

Several researchers are operating in numerous sign languages like yank signing, British signing, Taiwanese signing, etc. however few works has been created progress on Kannada signing. The hearing impaired individual becomes neglected from the society as a

result of the traditional individuals ne'er attempt to learn neither ISL nor attempt to move with the hearing impaired individuals. This becomes a curse for them and then they largely stay uneducated and isolated. Therefore recognition of signing was introduced that has not solely been necessary from engineering purpose of read however conjointly for the impact on society.

The paper aims to bridge the gap between North American country and therefore the hearing impaired individuals by introducing an affordable signing Recognition technique which is able to enable the user to grasp the means of the sign while not the assistance of any skilled translator. Several techniques are utilized by completely different researchers for recognizing sign languages or different hand gestures. Some researchers worked with static hand gestures, whereas some worked with video and real time. Singha, J. and Das, K. [1] worked with static pictures and this paper, Karhunen-Loeve remodel was used for recognition of various signs however was restricted to gestures of solely single hand. Accuracy rate obtained was 96%. Bhuyan achieved a success rate of 93% in his paper wherever he used undiversified Texture Descriptors to calculate the inflexed positions of fingers and abduction angle variations were conjointly thought of options in were extracted mistreatment Gabor filter and PCA and ANN used for recognition of the Ethiopian linguistic communication with a high success rate of ninety eight.5%. Bhuyan, M. et.al [2] In his paper used Cam shift formula for chase of hand and for options, Hauds off Distance and Fourier Descriptor were thought of. Recognition was achieved mistreatment Genetic formula. Admasu, Y. F. and Raimond, K. [3], Kannada linguistic communication was recognized mistreatment Eigen price weighted geometrician distance based mostly classifier with associate accuracy rate of ninety seven. It removed the problem faced by for gestures mistreatment each hands.

Many analysis works [4, 5] has been through with the video and real time. Chou used HMM for recognition of hand gestures consisting of each hands with associate accuracy rate of ninety four. Neural Network based mostly options and Hidden Mark Model was employed in [6] for recognizing varied hand gestures in video. Starner, T. and Pentland, A [7] used Hidden Mark Model for recognition of yank linguistic communication and achieved successful rate of ninety nine his work was restricted to colored gloves. Paulraj, M. P et.al [8] skin filtering, moment invariants based mostly options on with ANN was used for recognition of various gestures with successful rate of 92.85%. Were works done to acknowledge Taiwanese sign. Liang, R. H. and Ouhyoung, M [9] Used Hidden Mark Model in real time. However their work was restricted to use of knowledge gloves and recognition of single hand gestures with an occasional accuracy rate of eighty four. Tsai, B. L. and Huang, C. L. [10] constant issue of mistreatment colored gloves was gift however each static and dynamic hand gestures might be recognized mistreatment Support vector machines and Hidden Marko Model.

Ramesh M. Kagalkar and Dr. S.V. Gumaste, [12] reviews the intensive state of the art in automatic recognition of continuous signs, from different languages, supported the information sets used, features computed, technique used, and recognition rates achieved. In this paper discover that, in the past, most work has been tired finger-spelled words and isolated sign recognition, but recently, there has been vital progress within the recognition of signs embedded briefly continuous sentences. Paper tend to conjointly realize that researchers are getting down addressing the necessary down-side of extracting and integration non-manual data that is gift in face and head movement and present results from experiments integration of non-manual options.

Amit kumar and Ramesh Kagalkar [13] paper is going to construct a framework and techniques for the programmed acknowledgment of the Marathi communication via gestures. Through giving instructing classes to the reason for preparing the hard of hearing sign client in Marathi. The framework does oblige hand to be appropriately adjusted to the camera and does not require any wearable sensors. A substantial arrangement of tests has been utilized as a part of the framework to perceive confined words from the standard Marathi communication through signing, which are taken before the camera with distinctive hard of hearing sign client. The framework perceive some extremely essential components of gesture based communication and to make an interpretation of them to content and the other way around. Amit kumar and Ramesh Kagalkar [14] paper address the hand gesture recognition system can provide an opportunity for deaf persons to communicate with normal people without the need of an interpreter or intermediate. Work is going to build a systems and methods for the automatic recognition of Marathi sign language. Through that we are providing teaching classes for the purpose of training the deaf sign user in Marathi. The system does require hand to be properly aligned to the camera and does not need any special color markers, glove or wearable sensors. A large set of samples has been used in proposed system to recognize isolated words from the standard Marathi sign language which are taken in front of camera by different deaf sign user. We intend to recognize some very basic elements of sign language and to translate them to text.

Amit kumar and Ramesh Kagalkar [15] this paper presents an Automatic translation system for gesture of manual alphabets in Marathi sign language. It deals with images of bare hands, which allows the user to interact with the system in a natural way. Here system provides an opportunity for deaf persons to communicate with normal people without the need of an interpreter. The first step of this system is to create a database of Marathi sign language. Hand segmentation is the most crucial step in every hand gesture recognition system since if we get better segmented output, better recognition rates can be achieved. The work also includes efficient and robust hand segmentation and tracking algorithm to achieve better recognition rates. A large set of samples has been used to recognize 43 isolated words from the standard Marathi sign language.

# 2 System Overview

### 2.1 KSL Alphabets





Fig. 1. A set of 16 Kannada Swaragalu is listed.

The Kannada linguistic communication was developed so the deaf individual within the society will move with the conventional individual with none difficulties [19]. Here during this paper, we have got thought-about the alphabets of KSL that involves the utilization of either single hand or each hands. A complete of 554 alphabets were thought-about that is shown in Fig. 1. Kannada Language is a south Indian language spoken in Karnataka state of India. Kannada is originated from the Dravidian Language. Telugu, Tamil, Malayalam are the other South Indian Languages originated from Dravidian Language. Kannada and Telugu have almost the same script. Malayalam and Tamil have resemblance.

The description of Kannada script is the visual form of Kannada language. It originated from southern Bramhilipi of Ashokaperiod [20]. It underwent modifications periodically in the reign of Sathavahanas, Kadambas, Gangas, Rastrakutas, and Hoysalas. Even before seventh-Century, the Telugu-Kannada script was used in the inscriptions of the Kadambas of Banavasi and the early Chalukya of Badami in the west. From the middle of the seventh century the archaic variety of the Telugu-Kannada script developed a middle variety. The modern Kannada and Telugu scripts emerged in the thirteenth Century. Kannada script is also used to write Tulu, Konkani and Kodava languages.

The Kannada along with other Indian language scripts shares a large number of structural features. The writing system of Kannada script encompasses the principles governing the phonetics and a syllabic writing systems, and phonemic writing systems (alphabets). The effective unit of writing Kannada is the orthographic syllable consisting of a consonant and vowel (CV) core and optionally, one or more preceding consonants, with a canonical structure of ((C) CV. The orthographic syllable need not correspond exactly with a phonological syllable, especially when a consonant cluster is involved, but the writing system is built on phonological principles and tends to correspond quite closely to pronunciation [21]. The orthographic syllable is built up of alphabetic pieces, the actual letters of Kannada script. These consist of distinct character types: Consonant letters, independent vowels and the corresponding dependent vowel signs. In a text sequence, these characters are stored in logical phonetic order.

1. Vowels (Swaragalu/Swaras) Vowels are the independently existing letters which are called Swaras. They are,

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


Fig. 2. A set of 36 Kannada vayanjanas is listed.




Fig. 3. A set of 14 matras of kannada is listed.




Fig. 4. Proposed system overview.

**Detection of Hand Gestures.** Skin Filtering was performed to the input video frames for detection of hand gestures.




Fig. 6. Flow diagram of hand gestures detection.

Skin Filtering could be a technique used for separating the skin colored regions from the non-skin colored regions. The steps employed in this skin filtering are shown in Fig. 6.




Fig. 7. Shows graph of success rate of vowels.




Fig. 8. Shows graph of success rate of consonants.




Fig. 9. Screen snap shot of training performed during implementation.
